NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 25 of the industries (development and regulation) Act. 1951 (Central Act. 45 of 1951) read with item (vi) of subclause (2) of clause 10 of the cement control order 1967, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendment to the schedule to Notification issued in G.O. Ms. No. 689, Industries & Commerce, dt. 6th July 1974 and published at pages 1 and 2 of part-II extraordinary of the A.P. Gazette, dt. 9th July 1974.

AMENDMENT

For the schedule of to the said notification, the following scheduled shall be substituted, namely.

THE SCHEDULE

Distances by road to lace of business from factory leading point/nearest rail head.	Rate of transport charged.
1. Upto and including 5 kms	7.50 per M.T.
2. Beyond 5 kms upto and including 40 kms	Rs. 7.50 per M.T. Plus Rs. 0.39 per M.T. per KM above 5 kms.
3. Beyond 40 kms upto and including 500 kms	Rs. 20-40 per MT plus Rs. 0.30 per KM above 40 KMs
4. Beyond 500 kms	Rs. 150/- per MT plus 0.27 per MT per KM above 500 KMs.

2. In case of transportation of Cement by road from the factory loading point to the place of business, the stockists shall be allowed transport cost calculated at the rates specified in the schedule loss railway freight reimbursement by the factory as admissible.
